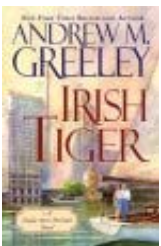

An Irish Country Village by Patrick Taylor



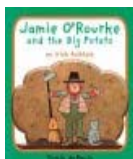

Long Lost

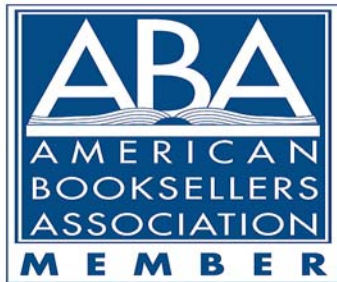
